Diabetes – ACEI/ARB Therapy

Purpose: The purpose of this measure is to identify and track members who are diagnosed with diabetes and are not filling an ACEI or an ARB.

(denominator)</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Members diagnosed with diabetes (250.xx) <li style="text-align: center;">AND o Members diagnosed with hypertension (401.xx) <li style="text-align: center;">OR o Members diagnosed with Proteinuria (791.0) <p>Exclusions: Pregnant Members (640-649, V22 or V23) or members < 6 years old</p> |
| <p>What Pharmacy Claim Data is evaluated? (numerator)</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Claims for single and multi-ingredient products containing either an ACEI or an ARB |
| <p>When does the analysis occur?</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Reviews claims from the previous 3 months o Updated Monthly |
| <p>Where can I get this information?</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Monthly NaviNet report updates reflect Gaps In Care for PCP practice panel membership. o Quarterly printed reports sent to PCPs reflect Gaps In Care for PCP practice panel membership. o Panel membership results include indicators for this Gaps In Care measure as “At Risk” |
| <p>Why does my member have an “At Risk” status?</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Pharmacy claims show a failure to fill either an ACEI or an ARB in the previous 3 months |
