## Specifications for Gaps in Care

### Short-term Adherence – Renin Inhibitors

**Purpose:** The purpose of this measure is to identify and track members who are late in filling a renin inhibitor (e.g. ACEI, ARB, or direct renin inhibitor).

<b>Who is Included?</b> (denominator)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Members with claims for single and multi- ingredient products an ACEI, ARB, or direct renin inhibitor</li> </ul>
<b>What Pharmacy Claim Data is evaluated?</b> (numerator)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Members who are between 20 and 100 days past their anticipated refill date</li> </ul>
<b>When does the analysis occur?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Reviews claims from the previous 12 months</li> <li>○ Updated Monthly</li> </ul>
<b>Where can I get this information?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Monthly NaviNet report updates reflect Gaps In Care for PCP practice panel membership.</li> <li>○ Quarterly printed reports sent to PCPs reflect Gaps In Care for PCP practice panel membership.</li> <li>○ Panel membership results include indicators for this Gaps In Care measure as “At Risk”</li> </ul>
<b>Why does my member have an “At Risk” status?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Pharmacy claims show a renin inhibitor is overdue for refill by 20 to 100 days.</li> </ul>
